- **WHEREAS,** The U.S. District Court further ruled that the County of Oneida would be barred from enforcing tax foreclosure procedures, and

- **RESOLVED,** That the Oneida County Board of Legislators sends a Home Rule Request to Representatives in the NYS Senate and NYS Assembly urging the introduction and passage of Senate Bill No. S7518 and Assembly Bill No.A10563 to amend the State Finance Law in relation to the Oneida Indian Nation Real Property Tax Depository Fund and to extend such provisions through June 30, 2010, unless such taxes are paid sooner, and it is further
