## LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTORY "D" OF 2014 LOCAL LAW NO. OF 2014

RE: LOCAL LAW INTRODUCTOR "D" OF 2014 EXTENDING THE HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX CURRENTLY IMPOSED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2012 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 644 OF THE LAWS OF 1984, AS AMENDED

**Leglislative Intent:** The intent of this Local Law is to extend the Oneida County Hotel Occupancy Tax, the purpose of such tax being to promote Oneida County, its cities, towns and villages in order to increase convention, trade show and tourist business in the County.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of County Legislators of the County of Oneida, State of New York, as follows:

- 1. Section 24 of Local law No. 3 of 1993, as previously amended by Local Law #2 of 2012, is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2. This Local Law shall remain in full force and effect only through December 31, 2017.

This Local Law shall take effect on January 1, 2015.
