COVID-19 VACCINATOR

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under the general direction of the Public Health Director, the incumbent of this class will work with a team of clinicians to conduct activities related to administering COVID-19 vaccines. The incumbent will prepare COVID-19 vaccinations for administration according to manufacturer and County instruction, administer intermuscular injections, monitor patients during observation period and document all patient care. Additionally, Vaccinators will adhere to handling standards during admixture, preparation, and transport of COVID-19 vaccine within the work location, and maintains awareness of medication storage guidelines, including cold chain considerations. The incumbent performs related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Prepares COVID-19 vaccinations for administration according to manufacturer and County instruction;
Administers intermuscular injections;
Monitors patients during observation period and documents all patient care;
Adheres to handling standards during admixture, preparation, and transport of COVID-19 vaccine within the work location;
Maintains awareness of medication storage guidelines, including cold chain considerations.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION: Qualification to administer COVID-19 vaccine in New York State pursuant to Law, Rule, Regulation, and/or Executive Order.
