MEETING MINUTES March 19, 2024 4:30 PM

The meeting was opened at 4:30 pm by Chairperson Dave Glenn. Approval of the February 20, 2024 minutes was tabled due to a lack of quorum.

Sauquoit Creek Flood Plain Restoration and Bank Stabilization Program Update

Maggie R. provided a brief update on the projects in the Town of Whitestown. Project 1 has a tight budget using FEMA funds to complete all the required repairs. Oneida County cannot do the work as getting into the creek is a concern. A new cost estimate is needed to see what other funding can be secured. Project 3 involves the purchase of land with the Forest Conservation Grant along with the enhancement of Project 2. The town is looking to work on the enhancement in 2024 as there are no required permits from NYS DEC.

The cooperative agreement between the Town of Whitestown and USDA NRCS for the home buy-out program has been signed. Once that agreement is signed, the Town can take more control of the project and will be sending communication to participants about upcoming milestones in the next week. Once titles are cleared, home closings will be starting this year and demolition in the next year. Maggie informed the group that a consultant will be in the neighborhood taking pictures of all the homes as part of the cultural study.

Kristin did not have any new updates.

Treasurer's Report

The balance in the Commission's bank account is \$126,246.87. There were no new bills. Approval of treasurer's report was tabled due to a lack of quorum.
