Engine Company Operations

Engine Company Operations is intended to build on skills and knowledge established in the Firefighter 1 course. In this course we will broaden the knowledge and skill base of handline selection, handline placement, handline operation, as well as nozzle operation and selection, and standpipe operations.

This course is designed to meet the knowledge, skills, and abilities outlined in NFPA 1410: Standard on Training for Initial Emergency Scene Operations. The course will culminate with a Live Burn Exercise that focuses on handline placement and operational efficiency of the Engine Company.
