# **TRAINING BULLETIN**



## **Firefighter Assist and Search Team** **(FAST)**

**FAST:** The firefighter as a member of a FAST operation will identify the tools and staffing requirements for a FAST operation develop a rescue plan for a missing, lost or trapped firefighter; demonstrate rope search techniques, and demonstrate removing firefighter/victim up a stairwell, up or down through a hole in a floor/roof, moving a downed firefighter out of a window, and lowering a firefighter down a ladder. This course requires students to perform a number of practical evolutions with self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA)

The course consists of 15 hours of training presented on as follows:

LOCATION: North Bay

DATES: September 5, 7, 13, 16

Class starts at 6:30 pm on Weeknights - Daytime classes begin at 9:00 am

**Prerequisites:** Firefighter Survival and SCBA Qualified
