Firefighter II

Designed as the last step in initial level training for interior structural firefighters and/or who will serve as team or group leaders under the general supervision of an office. Builds on Basic and Intermediate Firefighter Courses and introduces new more advanced areas that will be expanded in other training program. With the exception of those NFPA Firefighter Level II objectives pertaining to Vehicle Extrication techniques, a firefighter receives the training components equivalent to those found within NFPA Firefighter II Standard after they have successfully completed the Advanced Firefighter Training Courses.

Designed for: Interior structural firefighters and/or firefighters who may serve as team or group leader.

The course consists of 27 hours of training presented on as follows:

LOCATION: Westmoreland

DATES: March 29 & April 4, 6, 11, 13, 18, 20, 26 & May 4, 10, 13, 17

Class starts at 6:30 P.M. - Daytime class starts at 9:00 A.M.

Prerequisites: Firefighter I; SCBA Qualified; Training Letter
