NWCG Basic Incident Command System (I-200)

The complexity of incident management, coupled with the growing need for multi-agency and multifunctional involvement on incidents, has increased the need for a single standard incident management system that can be used by all emergency response disciplines, the Basic ICS course is part of the National Training Curriculum. Under Executive Order #26, March 5 1996, NYS Governor George E. Patacki established the National Interagency Incident Management-Incident Command System as the standard command and control system during emergency operations.

The course consists of 12 hours of training presented on as follows:
