## SCBA/Interior Firefighting Operations (SCBA/IFO)

is designed to train the BEFO graduate to become an interior structural firefighter. Taken from the IFSTA Essentials of Fire Fighting and Fire Department Operations 6th Edition, this course adds the interior structural firefighter knowledge, skills, and abilities to the foundational theories and techniques learned in the BEFO course. The combined courses prepare the student to perform interior structural firefighting operations under the direct supervision of a company officer and meet the objectives of NFPA 1001, 2013 Edition, Firefighter I job performance requirements. The completion certificate for this course will state SCBA/ Interior Firefighting Operations-Firefighter-1. Successful completion of this course also allows the graduate to sit for the Firefighter-1 National Certification Examination.

The SCBA/IFO course is 16 units totaling 50 hours.
