

**Griffiss International Airport
Unmanned Aircraft Systems Test Site (UASTS)**

Privacy Policy

NOTICE---No data on individuals, except individual UAS qualification data of UAS pilots, operators, maintainers, or others necessary to insure safety of operations and regulatory compliance, will be intentionally collected, retained, or used for any purpose. The only data permitted to be collected on the UASTS is UAS safety and engineering research and development data.

CHOICE---Proponents conducting UAS testing on the Griffiss UASTS must permit UAS safety data to be collected and forward transferred to the Federal Aviation Administration. No individual persons "opt-out" procedure is required as no data on individuals, except as noted-above, will be collected or retained. Any individual information, other than that noted-above, that is inadvertently collected will be destroyed.

ONWARD TRANSFER---Transfers of data to third parties may only occur to other organizations that follow adequate data protection principles.

SECURITY---All reasonable effort will be made to prevent loss of collected information. Should an inadvertent loss of data occur, the affected parties will be notified immediately and appropriate mitigation procedures implemented.

DATA INTEGRITY---Only relevant UAS safety, engineering, research, and development data will be collected.

ACCESS---Access to data collected at the UASTS is governed by various state or federal laws and regulations. Written requests for access to UASTS test information will be processed in accordance with applicable law and regulations. Written comments regarding this Privacy Policy are always welcome.

ENFORCEMENT---Each UAS test flight must have a UASTS approved flight plan prior to flight operations. The UASTS will review that flight plan to insure the Privacy Policy is complied with. Non-compliance with the Privacy Policy will result in "no flight test" until the non-compliance is remedied.
