ALL CATS, DOGS, AND FERRETS 3 MONTHS OR OLDER MUST HAVE A CURRENT RABIES VACCINATION, EVEN IF THEY STAY INDOORS

DOGS AND CATS NEED TO BE VACCINATED AT 3 MONTHS OLD, 1 YEAR, AND THEN ONCE EVERY 3 YEARS

PETS WILL RECEIVE A 1 YEAR CERTIFICATE IF NO PRIOR PROOF OF RABIES IS SHOWN

FERRETS MUST BE VACCINATED EVERY YEAR

DOGS NEED TO BE ON A LEASH, AND CATS NEED TO BE IN A CARRIER, LAUNDRY BASKET, OR PILLOWCASE

NO EXAMS WILL BE GIVEN

A 10 DOLLAR DONATION PER PET IS ASKED TO HELP WITH COSTS
