WAYS & MEANS

In September 2013 the Department of Public Works solicited qualifications from NYSERDA qualified installers for the development of a Solar Photovoltaic (SPV) installation at County facilities in conjunction with New York State Energy Research and Development Authority's (NYSERDA) large-scale solar program. The goal was to establish a list of qualified SPV project developers that would be authorized to submit, on behalf of Oneida County, applications for future NYSERDA PON opportunities.

The Oneida County Sheriff's Office elected to work with one of the qualified solar developers, Borrego Solar, for two solar projects to benefit the Oneida County Jail, which has significant full-time, year-round energy consumption. After submitting for NYSERDA funding on behalf of the projects, Borrego Solar was awarded two funding for two (2) separate SPV project with a combined output of approximately 3.6 MW in September 2014.

Approximately five (5) acres of County owned property adjacent to the Oneida County Jail will be used for an 895 kW project at the jail facility, and approximately fifteen (15) acres will be used for a 2,700 kW project at a leased third-party owned site in Schuyler, NY. Maps and layouts of each of the SPV installations are included in the enclosed documentation.

Under current electric utility regulations and market prices the financial benefit to the County from the combined 3.6 MW systems would be approximately \$128,341.00 annually. Savings would increase or decrease depending on regulations and market prices. A Solar Power Services Agreement would assign Oneida County all risk associated with electric utility regulations and market prices. Therefore, it is possible that Oneida County would realize a financial deficit. However, to the best of our knowledge the probability of this occurring is extremely low.

The County will need to enter into two Solar Power Agreements to purchase the on-site net electrical output from the systems for a period of twenty-five years, with the ability to renew for two successive five year renewal terms (one term for each project). For the Oneida County Jail project, the County will need to grant an easement over County-owned property at 6075 Judd Road in Oriskany. The County will enter into a sublease with Borrego Solar for the 2.7 MW system on third-party owned property.

Please review the enclosed two Solar Power Services Agreements and if acceptable, please forward to the Oneida County Board of Legislators for consideration at the next meeting as timing is critical. Fully executed contracts must be forwarded to NYSERDA no later than January 15, 2015. I respectfully request review and consideration by the Board on January 14, 2015.
