BARBER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: An employee in this class provides adequate barber service. Duties would also include the maintenance of barber tools and other equipment in sanitary condition. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Gives haircuts and shaves, in accordance with personal need;
Sharpens and sterilizes barber tools and maintains working areas and equipment in sanitary condition;
May give shampoos and perform other standard barber services.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of, and ability to adequately provide, standard barber services; ability to get along well with others; neatness and good appearance.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from a recognized school of barbering.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Eligibility for a license to practice as a barber in New York State; possession of license at time of appointment.
