## **WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR**

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** The incumbent in this position has immediate charge of the repair and maintenance of buildings, machinery and equipment at a wastewater treatment plant and its pumping stations. The duties involve responsibility for planning, supervising and participating in the repair and maintenance of buildings, machinery and equipment at the wastewater treatment plant and its pumping stations. Responsibilities for automotive equipment is not a part of this job. The incumbent works under general supervision of the Chief Plant Operator, who reviews general program objectives. The incumbent is allowed considerable latitude in deciding work methods. Supervision is exercised over the work of personnel. The incumbent performs related work as required.

**TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:** (Illustrative Only)

Has responsible charge of routine maintenance and repair activities for the wastewater treatment plant and pumping stations;  
Plans, oversees and participates in maintenance and repair jobs;  
Establishes a comprehensive preventive maintenance schedule and ensures compliance;  
Estimates the cost of labor and parts for repair/upgrade projects;  
Has charge of a running inventory of parts and equipment;  
Evaluates the complexity of repair jobs or upgrades and, in the case of major projects, recommends and works with outside contractors;  
Assists in the preparation of annual budget.

**FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:** Thorough knowledge of plant operations, operation, maintenance and repair of pumps and auxiliary equipment; good knowledge of the uses and methods of repairing hydraulic and pneumatic equipment; good knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and safety precautions of the electrical/mechanical trades; general knowledge of mechanical trades; ability to read and work from plans, specifications and rough sketches; ability to plan, organize and supervise the work of others; ability to solve operating and maintenance problems as they occur.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** four (4) years of experience in the maintenance and repair of pumping machinery and auxiliary equipment, two (2) years of which must have involved wastewater treatment equipment.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at time of application. License must remain valid throughout appointment in order to meet transportation requirements of the job.

**NOTE:** Verifiable part-time experience as described above will be pro-rated toward meeting full-time experience requirements.
