

**Oneida County Office of Pistol Licensing
Notice of Training Requirement**

NOTICE to all applicants from the Oneida County Pistol Licensing Office as to what training is required to obtain a pistol license.

The only training requirement to receive an application for a New York State pistol license, restricted or unrestricted, is the completion of the first eight-hours of The National Rifle Association Basic Pistol Course.

The Oneida County Pistol Licensing Office **does not require** any additional training, including follow-up classes in “live fire” or personal protection classes, in order to obtain any type or class of license. The first eight-hours of the NRA Basic Pistol Course is all that is required.

Statement of Prospective Applicant

I have read the above notice, and I understand that I am only required to complete the first eight-hours of The National Rifle Association Basic Pistol Course to obtain a pistol license, whether it be restricted or unrestricted.

I also understand that the Oneida County Pistol Licensing Office does not require that I take personal protection classes or “live fire” classes in order to obtain the pistol license I seek, be it restricted or unrestricted.
