Oneida County 2003 TAP Data

This Appendix shows the response rate (for each question of the Oneida County 2003 TAP Survey) for the total participants, then by gender and then by grade (7th, 9th and 11th). Of the 150 questions in the 2003 TAP Survey, 89 were also part of the Oneida County 1999 TAP Survey. For these questions the total response rate for 1999 is shown.

Hopefully, this Appendix is helpful to school districts, in that they can compare the response rate for their students with those of the County as a whole, and to others in the community who might use the information for program planning and grant writing.
