A deposit of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) will be required for each set. If plans and specifications are delivered via mail then a deposit of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) plus shipping and handling fees will be required for each set. Cash deposits will not be accepted. Also required is Federal ID Number or Social Security Number at time of purchase. All deposit checks are to be made payable to the COUNTY OF ONEIDA. A refund will be made, in the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), to Bidder(s) or Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) to Non-Bidders, for the return of all the sets in good condition within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of Bids.

Bids must be submitted upon the proposal form(s) furnished, and must not be detached from the proposal booklet. A deposit in the amount of 5% of the base bid will be required and is subject to the conditions provided in the Instruction to Bidders. This deposit shall consist of a bid bond or certified check payable to the COUNTY OF ONEIDA. Failure to submit a bid bond or certified check with bid will result in automatic disqualification of bid. Failure to submit a bid upon the proposal form(s) furnished by the Oneida County Department of Public Works or submittal of form(s) detached from the proposal booklet will result in automatic disqualification of bid.

A pre-bid meeting has been scheduled for **May 11, 2016 at 11:00 AM**. All bidders will meet at the First Floor Conference Room at the Oneida County Department of Public Works located at 6000 Airport Road, Oriskany, New York.

The successful bidder must furnish a Performance Bond for the amount not less than 100% of the bid price and a Labor and Material Payment Bond in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.
