

ADVERTISEMENT - INVITATION TO BID

Sealed Proposals, subject to the conditions contained herein will be received by the **ONEIDA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION** at the Griffiss International Airport Terminal Building, 660 Hangar Road, Suite 223, Rome, NY 13441 until **June 1, 2018 at 1:30 pm** then publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing all labor and materials and performing all work for:

RUNWAY RECONSTRUCTION-PHASE I
GRIFFISS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; ONEIDA COUNTY, ROME, NEW YORK

This project includes the first section of existing concrete runway reconstruction with an area of approximately 4,820 feet long by 200 feet wide. The project includes reconstruction of the runway shoulders at 35 feet wide and the blast pad at 400 feet in length. Project tasks will include profile cold milling, limited excavation of concrete pavement, rubblizing the existing concrete pavement and placement of bituminous asphalt pavement with FAA item P-401. Project incidentals include turf grading, pavement markings, runway grooving and airfield lighting modifications. In addition, all existing power distribution equipment in the electrical vault, located in the center core of building #100, will be replaced in this project. The project will be constructed under a single General Construction contract with a single base bid. Construction is expected to start in the spring of 2019.

The Contract Documents (consisting of the Advertisement, Proposal, Agreement and the Specifications) and the Contract Drawings must be obtained from the Oneida County Purchasing Office, 6th Floor, 800 Park Ave., Utica, NY 13501. A deposit of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) will be required for each set. If plans and specifications are delivered via mail then a Vendor FedEx or UPS account number for shipping must be supplied with the deposit check. Cash deposits will not be accepted. Also required is Federal ID Number or Social Security Number at time of purchase. All deposit checks are to be made payable to the COUNTY OF ONEIDA. A refund will be made, in the amount of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), to Bidder(s) or Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) to Non-Bidders, for the return of all the sets in good condition within thirty (30) days of award or rejection of Bids.

Copies of the above described Contract Documents may be examined at no expense at the Oneida County Department of Aviation; Oneida County Purchasing Department; Dataflow, Attn: McGraw Hill Construction/Dodge; Mohawk Valley Builders Exchange; and the Syracuse Builders Exchange.

Bids must be submitted upon the proposal form(s) furnished, and must not be detached from the separate proposal book. A deposit in the amount of 5% of the bid will be required. This deposit shall consist of a bid bond or certified check payable to the COUNTY OF ONEIDA. Failure to submit a bid bond or certified check with bid will result in automatic disqualification of bid. Failure to submit a bid upon the proposal form(s) in the proposal book furnished by the Oneida County Department of Aviation will result in automatic disqualification of bid. Performance and Material & Labor payment bonds will be required for an amount not less than 100% of bid price. Packages containing bids must be sealed marked and addressed to the Director of Purchasing, Griffiss International Airport, 660 Hangar Road, Suite 223, Rome, NY 13441. Also mark on the envelope or package the Bid Reference Number and type of work for which the proposal is submitted.
