I am submitting this Purchase of Services Agreement with Mohawk Valley Community Action Agency for review and approval by the Board of Legislators.

The Department has contracted with this agency for Parent Aide Services for several years. The Contractor's Strengthening Families Program (SFP) will provide parent aide community-based services to 75-85 families at any one time to prevent placement into foster care and to return children to a permanent living arrangement. The Contractor will pursue an aggressive policy regarding permanency planning for children at risk of entering care and those returning from care. The goal is to provide Preventive Services and re-direct the families to avoid child abuse, neglect, and out-of-home placement.

This Agreement is for the term January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2025, and has a maximum total cost of \$1,635,938.00. The local cost to support this effort is 27.18 % or \$444,647.95. This service is a vital element in our Preventive Services Program.

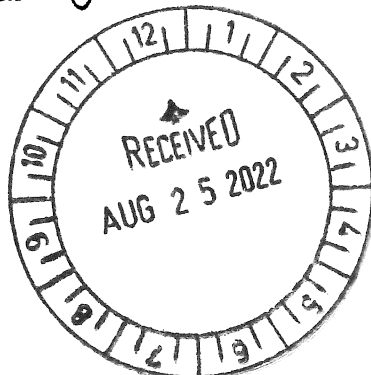

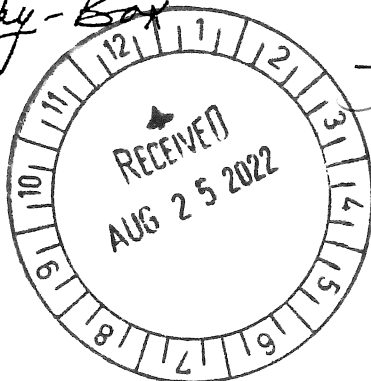

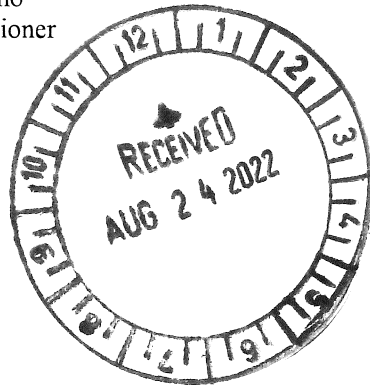

Dear County Executive Picente:

This letter is requesting that the Oneida County Board of Legislators pass a Resolution allowing Oneida County to make applications to the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation for up to \$433,427 and to the Joint Utilities of New York for up to \$558,149 in funding for electric vehicle supply equipment and infrastructure in six locations.

The DEC-ZEV Infrastructure Grant Program provides municipalities with financial assistance for the purchase and installation of electric vehicle supply equipment (EVSE). The EV Make Ready Program provides financial assistance to support the development of electric infrastructure through incentives for costs associated with preparing a site for EV charger installation for Oneida County.

Oneida County intends to partner with Plug-In Stations Online (PISO) to prepare these applications, implement the project, and administer the grants. Each grant award is site specific with grants totaling the cost of the project with \$433,127 for the DEC-ZEV Infrastructure grants and \$558,149 with the EV Make Ready Program (See Exhibit A). There is a 0-20% match requirement for the DEV-ZEV Infrastructure Grant, dependent on if all grants are approved, zero County dollars will be spent. This funding will be used in conjunction with the EV Make Ready Program.

If you agree that Oneida County should make applications to NYS DEC and the Joint Utilities of New York for the installation of electric vehicle charging stations on Oneida County properties, I would respectfully request that you forward it to the Oneida County Board of Legislators for their consideration in adopting a formal resolution. Please feel free to call me if any additional information is required. Thank you for your continued support.



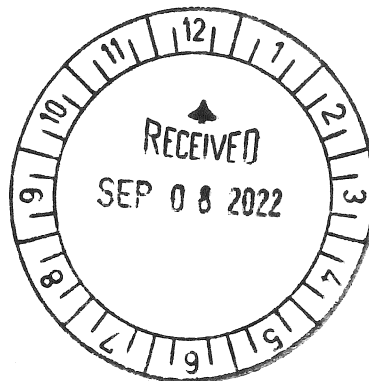
