

Dear County Executive Picente,

As part of the radio project whose goal it is to improve public safety, we would like to enter into a lease agreement with New Cingular Wireless, PCS (d/b/a AT&T) for a tower to be constructed on County property. AT&T has agreed to build a tower at 120 Base Road in Oriskany at their cost, and then turn over ownership of the tower to the County for purposes of installing public safety radio equipment. In exchange, they are requesting a no-cost lease of space for placement of their cellular phone equipment.

We consider this portion of the project a "win-win" for the taxpayers of Oneida County, as it will result in significant up-front cost-savings, allowing us to purchase more equipment for use by first-responders within our existing budget. Should the enclosed lease meet with your approval, I respectfully request that you forward the same to the Board of Legislators for action at their next meeting.

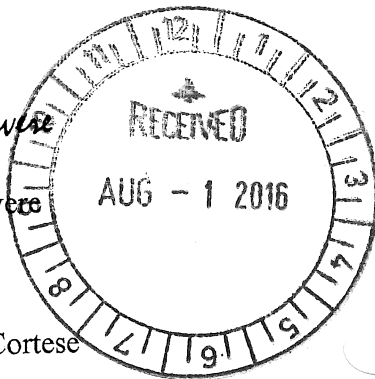

A.) Amendment of Capital Project H-489 – Griffiss Intl. – Phase 5 Taxiway Rehabilitation Construction,

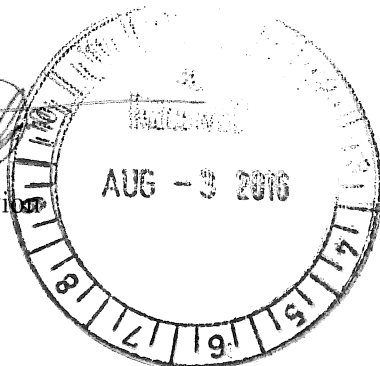


