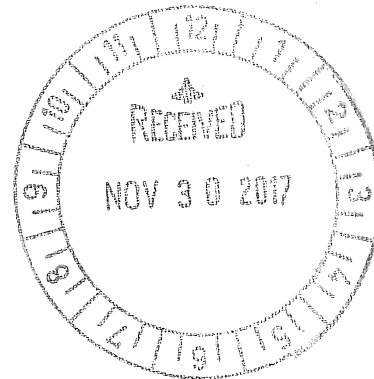

LOCAL LAW NO. ____ OF 2017

A LOCAL LAW EXTENDING THE HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX CURRENTLY IMPOSED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 2014 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 644 OF THE LAWS OF 1984, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY LEGISLATORS OF THE COUNTY OF ONEIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION A. TITLE

This Local Law shall be known as the “Local Law Extending the Hotel Occupancy Tax Currently Imposed by Local Law No. 4 of 2014 Pursuant to Chapter 644 of the Laws of 1984, as Amended.”

SECTION B. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The intent of this Local Law is to extend the Oneida County Hotel Occupancy Tax, the purpose of such tax being to promote Oneida County, its cities, towns and villages in order to increase convention, trade show and tourist business in the County.

SECTION C. EXTENSION OF THE HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX

Section 24 of Local Law No. 3 of 1993, as previously amended by Local Law No. 4 of 2014 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“This Local Law shall remain in full force and effect only through December 31, 2019.”
