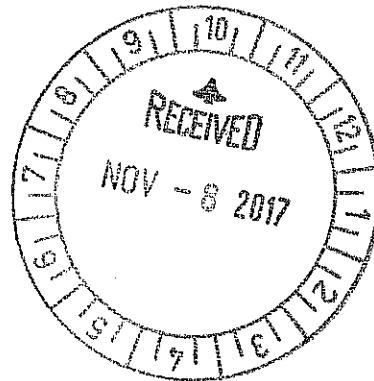

Attached are two resolutions relating to the ongoing Oneida County Sewer District projects required to comply with the terms of the DEC consent order. The Board of Legislators approved the original bond authorization on January 14, 2015 for \$117,000,000 for the first phase of the consent order project financed with bonds issued through EFC. The attached resolutions approve the next phases of improvements at an estimated additional cost of \$160,000,000 and authorize bonds to be issued to fund the new projects HG570, HG571, HG572 and HG573 with budgets to be established under separate resolutions.

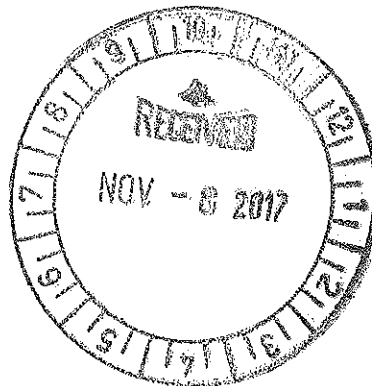

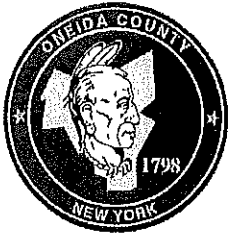

Dear County Executive Picente,

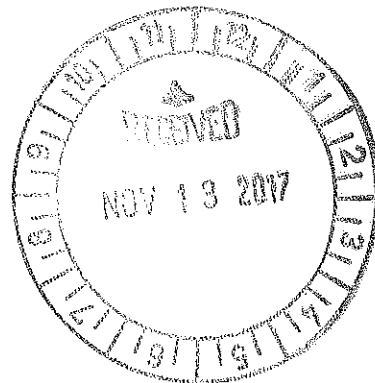
