





Dear County Executive Picente,

Reconstruction of the 10th floor at the Oneida County Office Building is on schedule. Phase I work is complete, including renovation of the 9th floor for temporary occupancy. Phase II construction contracts were awarded by the Oneida County Board of Acquisition and Contact on October 16, 2018. Phase II work includes construction of the County Executive's Office suite, the County Attorney's Office suite, renovation of men's and women's restrooms, and installation of primary HVAC equipment for the entire floor. Plans and specifications are 80% complete for Phase III work, which includes construction of the Board of Legislators suite.

The original capital project budget request for 2018 was prepared with the assumption that the 9th floor would be reconstructed in 2018-2019. In early 2018 it was determined that the 10th floor must be reconstructed in 2018-2019. Primary reasons included space allocation and availability of swing space. Reconstruction of the 10th floor is significantly more complicated and significantly more expensive than any other floor. Contributing factors include minor reconstruction on the 9th floor, additional HVAC systems for Board of Legislators chamber and conference rooms, +18' floor to ceiling height, additional technology for executive and legislative suites, and appropriate level of finishes, furniture, and technology for the Board of Legislators chamber.

The current unencumbered balance in Capital Project H-305 is approximately \$150,000.00. The cost estimate for Phase III work items is approximately \$2,600.000.00. Therefore, I respectfully request a budget increase in Capital Project H-305 in the amount of \$2,450,000.00.

Dear County Executive Picente,

Reconstruction of Family Court and County offices at 301 W. Dominick St., Rome, is progressing. Construction contracts were successfully executed but very little contingency funding, remains in Capital Project H-523, Rome Family Court.

Additional expenditures are anticipated for work items including additional asbestos abatement, additional construction observation and administration services due to schedule complications, and additional professional consulting services due to unanticipated building code complications.

In addition, the City of Rome will construct a plaza on W. Dominick St. with a monument honoring historic contributions made by the Oneida Indian Nation and the historic geographic significance of the region that is now the City of Rome. The City of Rome has asked if Oneida County can contribute to the plaza via limited improvements to County property including an exterior stair from W. Dominick St. to the County's parking lot, exterior lighting improvements, and fence repairs.

The cost estimate for the aforementioned work items is approximately \$275,000.00. Therefore, I respectfully request a budget increase in Capital Project H-523 in the amount of \$275,000.00.
