As part of the FAA safe integration program, both the FAA and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) have contacted the six (6) FAA designated UAS test sites and advised of a five (5) year competitive program to submit proposals in response to initiatives defined by the two entities (the FAA and NASA) (Task Orders). Each Task Order will consist of a request for proposals from either the FAA or NASA which will provide a short period for submission of proposals, as short as 24 to 72 hours. The acceptance of a submitted proposal by the issuer (the FAA or NASA) will constitute a contract. As such, the proposals must be fully authorized by the County and binding upon the County when submitted. In order to participate in the safe integration program, it is necessary that an exception from the provisions of the Oneida County Charter and Code governing the authorization and execution of contracts be adopted by this Board allowing the County Executive to execute the proposals and ancillary agreements in a timely matter, now, therefore, be it hereby
