- WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Parking Agreement, the parking payment in any Renewal Term exercised by MVHS, Inc. shall be equal to the annual payment in year thirty (30) of the Initial Term, and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Parking Agreement, MVHS, Inc. shall share in long-term capital improvement costs to the parking garage equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of said costs, and shall make escrow deposits on an annual basis sufficient to fund a long-term capital improvement cost account, and
- WHEREAS, Pursuant to the Parking Agreement, MVHS, Inc. shall reimburse Oneida County for seventy-five (75%) of all utility costs associated with the parking garage, and
- WHERAS, Pursuant to the Parking Agreement, Oneida County shall be responsible for the day-to-day operation and maintenance of the parking garage, at its sole cost and expense, and MVHS, Inc. shall be responsible for all groundskeeping and landscaping around the parking garage, as well as snow and ice removal inside and outside of the parking garage at its sole cost and expense, and
- WHEREAS, In accordance with Oneida County Charter Section 2202, said Parking Agreement must be approved by the Oneida County Board of Legislators, now, therefore, be it hereby
- **RESOLVED,** That the Oneida County Board of Legislators hereby approves of and authorizes Oneida County Executive, Anthony J. Picente, Jr., to execute a Parking Agreement between Oneida County and MVHS, Inc upon the following terms and conditions: an Initial Term of thirty (30) years commencing on July 15, 2024, or the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy for the garage, whichever is later, with a renewal option by MVHS, Inc. for up to two (2) additional ten (10) year

terms; payment from MVHS, Inc. to Oneida County in the Initial Term equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of the County's debt service payments on bonding for \$32,659,425 calculated over a thirty (30) year payment term, said exact parking payment to be calculated once bonds are sold, and payment in any Renewal Term to be equal to the annual payment in year thirty (30) of the Initial Term; MVHS, Inc. to share in long-term capital improvement costs to the parking garage equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of said costs, and making escrow deposits on an annual basis sufficient to fund a long-term capital improvement cost account; MVHS, Inc. shall reimburse Oneida County for seventy-five (75%) of all utility costs associated with the parking garage; Oneida County shall be responsible for the day-to-day operation and maintenance of the parking garage, at its sole cost and expense; MVHS, Inc. shall be responsible for all groundskeeping and landscaping around the parking garage, as well as snow and ice removal inside and outside of the parking garage at its sole cost and expense; and upon such other terms and conditions contained in the Parking Agreement on file with the Clerk of this Board, including any non-material amendments.
