## **CORRECTION OFFICER - LIEUTENANT**

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** Employees in this class perform higher level supervisory and correctional work involving responsibility for the custody, security, and general well-being of inmates during an assigned shift. Work is performed under the general supervision of a Correction Officer-Captain, or Chief Deputy. At times, a Correction Officer-Lieutenant may be the highest-ranking employee on duty and will have full charge of the Correctional Facility. Supervision is exercised over lower ranking Correction Officers. Incumbent performs related work as required.

## TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Ensures that all security posts are covered during a shift;

Makes reassignments as needed to provide proper coverage;

Makes periodic rounds of the institution;

Oversees inmate activities during the shift;

Deals with emergency situations such as inmate illnesses, suicide attempts, disturbances, attempted escapes, etc.;

Takes periodic counts of inmates;

Provides training to Correction Officers;

Supervises and participates in inmates' rehabilitation;

Prepares and submits reports on inmate counts and activities occurring during the shift; Supervises the escorting of prisoners and overseeing of meals.

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

**<u>CHARACTERISTICS</u>**: Thorough knowledge and understanding of methods and techniques used in enforcing institutional discipline; thorough knowledge of regulations, practices and procedures employed in a modern penal institution; good knowledge of the techniques used in inmate rehabilitation; ability to supervise the work of others; resourcefulness and good judgment in dealing with emergencies; ability to maintain personnel and inmate status reports; initiative; industry and dependability.

**<u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>**: Thirty-six (36) months of experience as a full-time Correction Officer-Sergeant or an equivalent rank and title in any Correctional facility.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Eligibility for an appropriate level New York State Driver's License at the time of application. Possession of a valid license at time of appointment. This license must be maintained throughout appointment.
