FIRE EQUIPMENT MECHANIC

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> Performs skilled work in connection with the maintenance and repair of automotive and other mechanical equipment of a fire company. This is skilled work involving responsibility for the complete overhaul and repair of a variety of fire equipment. The work is performed under general supervision with considerable leeway allowed in planning and carrying out work assignments. The incumbent performs related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Performs skilled operations in the repair, maintenance and general overhaul of fire equipment such as fire truck bodies and engines, pumping and other mechanical equipment;

Installs, repairs and tests pumps, generators, spotlights on fire trucks;

Makes road tests to determine proper working condition of vehicles and apparatus;

Checks and adjusts or replaces spark plugs, carburetors, and points;

Lubricates wheel bearings, springs, transmissions, crank cases and universals and performs other routine maintenance tasks;

Makes mechanical repairs to all automotive equipment used by the fire department.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Thorough knowledge of standard automotive repair methods and of the terminology and tools of the trade; good knowledge of the maintenance and repair of fire equipment; demonstrated ability to use the tools and equipment of the heavy truck repair trade; ability to follow oral and written directions; ability to work from plans and specifications; mechanical aptitude; thoroughness; good physical condition.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or University with an Associates Degree in automotive mechanics, automotive specialist, automotive technology, automotive service or other related field; **OR**
- (B) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma **AND** two (2) years of full-time work experience as an automotive mechanic which shall have involved repairs and maintenance of heavy automotive equipment*; **OR**
- (C) Three (3) years of experience as defined in (B) above.

^{*&}lt;u>Heavy automotive equipment</u> refers to dump trucks, graders, bulldozers, rollers, shovels, cranes, tractors, snow loaders, etc.
