SEWER MAINTENANCE WORKER

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> This position exists in a town, and involves the performance of semi-skilled maintenance and repair work in the operation of a sewer system. Immediate supervision is usually received from a Supervisor or other higher-ranking employee. Occasionally Sewer Maintenance Workers may oversee the work of laborers on specific projects. The incumbent performs related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Cleans, repairs, and maintains storm and sanitary sewers;

Builds and repairs manholes and catch basins;

Removes obstructions from sewers with sewer rods;

Makes connections on main pipelines for house laterals;

Opens laterals in emergencies;

Participates in excavation and back-fill activities, in connection with above work;

May operate tapping machines, pumps, compressors, air hammers and caulking guns;

May operate a truck in connection with above work.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

<u>CHARACTERISTICS</u>: Some knowledge of the common practices, tools, terminology and principles involved in maintenance of a sewer system; ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions; ability to withstand heavy labor for extended periods; industry; dependability.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: One (1) year of experience in manual labor.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Possession of an appropriate level, valid New York State Driver's License at time of appointment. This license must be maintained throughout appointment.
