WATER METER READER (PART-TIME)

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> This work consists of reading water meters at consumers' homes, business establishments and municipal buildings and recording consumption. Leaks and other conditions resulting in waste of water are reported to supervisors for corrective action. The work is performed under general direction. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Reads and records water meter readings;

Reports damaged meters or water leaks to proper authorities for corrective action; Assists in collecting delinquent bills;

Investigates complaints of disputed meter readings;

Performs routine laboring tasks when not involved in reading meters.
