# **Local Government Efficiency Program**

The **Local Government Efficiency** (LGe) Program provides technical and financial assistance to local governments for projects that achieve savings and improve municipal efficiency through shared services and municipal reorganization.

- <u>Citizen Empowerment Tax Credit and Reorganization Empowerment Grants</u> aid local governments with municipal re-organization activities. (up to \$35 million)
- <u>Local Government Efficiency Grants</u> assist local governments develop and implement new opportunities for savings and service delivery efficiencies. (up to \$4 million)
- <u>Municipal Restructuring Fund</u> assists local governments fund implementation of large scale local government reorganization and modernization efforts. (up to \$25 million)

# Citizen Empowerment Tax Credit

- Additional annual aid available to reorganized local governments, not to exceed \$1,000,000.
- 15% of the combined real property taxes levied by each municipality involved in the consolidation or dissolution.
- At least 70% of aid must be used for property tax relief.

# Citizens Reorganization Empowerment Grant Program

- For the consolidation or dissolution of a local government pursuant to General Municipal Law Article 17A.
  - \$50,000 maximum for a study (\$25,000 of which can be expedited to petitioned local governments).
  - o \$50,000 maximum for planning or implementation of a municipal reorganization.

# **Local Government Efficiency Grant Program**

- · Competitive grants to local governments to implement new local government efficiency actions.
  - o Planning projects capped at \$12,500 per local government, not to exceed \$100,000.
  - o Implementation projects capped at \$200,000 per local government, not to exceed \$1,000,000.
- · Project applications are assessed on the expected fiscal impact, level of shared effort and service improvement.

# **Municipal Restructuring Fund Program**

- For transformative projects that demonstrate the broadest impact across local governments.
- Acceptance to the program is based upon the project type, scale, and potential municipal tax levy impact.
- Engages local governments in implementation of projects at different stages of readiness.
- · Sample projects could include:
  - Regionalization of services
  - General government restructuring
  - Department reorganization among multiple local governments
    - Police department consolidation
    - Multi-municipal highway department consolidation
    - Fire Service consolidation
