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## **COVID-19 Booster Vaccines Expand to Include 5-11 Year-Olds**

Doses Available at County Health Dept. Clinics

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recently approved the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine booster dose for individuals aged 5-11 years. This approval comes with recommendations that children this age receive the booster dose at least five months after the primary series, under the FDA's Emergency Use Authorization.

COVID-19 vaccines are recommended for all children 5 years-old and up. They are safe and they help protect children from getting seriously ill from COVID-19. COVID-19 vaccine protection may wane over time after the primary series and boosters can further enhance or restore protection. The best protection from serious illness or severe COVID-19 is through vaccination. Families with questions about this vaccination should consult with their child's pediatrician.

COVID-19 vaccinations are available throughout Oneida County as well as at the Oneida County Health Department clinics in Utica and Rome.
