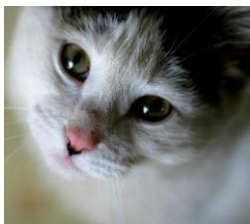

- All cats, dogs and ferrets 3 months or older must have a current rabies vaccination, even if they stay indoors.
- Dogs and cats need to be vaccinated at 3 months old, 1 year, and then once every 3 years.
- Pets will receive a 1 year certificate if no prior proof of rabies is shown.
- Ferrets must be vaccinated every year.
- Dogs need to be on a leash and cats need to be in a carrier or laundry basket.
- No exams will be given.
- A \$10 donation per pet is requested to help with costs.
