

2021 SENIOR FARMERS MARKET COUPONS

Age Requirement

All participants must be 60 or older and have proof of age if needed

Income Eligibility Requirements

Participant must not have received coupons from another source. One coupon booklet per single person household. Two coupon booklets per married couple but each must sign for a booklet. POA can pick up coupons for a senior **but must bring paperwork showing them, as Power of Attorney, no paperwork no coupons. A proxy can only pick up coupons with the NYS Proxy form signed by participant** which can be mailed to the participant by Oneida County Office for the Aging. **Coupons can be mailed** after necessary questions and paperwork is filled out to the satisfaction of the NYS requirements and Oneida Office for the Aging.

- Monthly gross income not to exceed \$1,986.00 for single person household
- Monthly gross income not to exceed \$2,686.00 for married couple or 2 person household
- Monthly gross income not to exceed \$3,386.00 for a 3 person household

All Participants must meet age and one of income eligibility requirements for the coupons.

Each SFMNP check booklet is worth \$20.00 and contains five (5) \$4.00 checks.

The coupons can only be used to purchase local fresh fruits & vegetables and cut herbs only (no plants).

You cannot use last year's coupons and if you lose your coupons they cannot be replaced.
