WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT ATTENDANT

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position exists in a wastewater treatment plant and involves responsibility for performance of various routine building cleaning, groundskeeping and laboring tasks. An employee in this class does not perform duties requiring certification, such as operating plant equipment and/or treating sewage, but may assist in such duties. The work is performed under supervision from the operator in charge of the shift. Supervision over the work of others is not a responsibility of employees in this class. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: (Illustrative Only)

Performs routine cleaning and minor maintenance duties in the care of plant buildings and equipment.

Lifts and carries or otherwise moves bags of chemicals, gas cylinders and other heavy materials or equipment from trucks or storage areas to other designated places in the plant;

Cuts grass, shovels or otherwise removes snow, and spreads salt and sand around walkways and driveways using hand and power driven equipment;

Cleans bar screens and rakes sand beds, filling with new sand when necessary;

Lubricates motors and pumps using hand or power equipment;

Aids in the maintenance and repair of plant equipment facilities and grounds;

May operate motor vehicles to pick up and deliver spare parts, gas cylinders, chemicals or other supplies;

Reports problems or equipment malfunction to supervisor for action;

Assists as required to maintain operations.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

CHARACTERISTICS: Working knowledge of routine building cleaning and minor maintenance procedures; ability to lift and carry heavy weights; willingness to work out-of-doors, occasionally in inclement weather and/or irregular hours, such as shifts; manual dexterity; physical strength.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATION: None.
