

# **Oneida County Office of Pistol Licensing**

## **Notice of Training Requirement**

**NOTICE** to all applicants from the Oneida County Pistol Licensing Office as to what training is required to obtain a pistol license.

The only training requirement to receive an application for a New York State pistol license, restricted or unrestricted, is the completion of the first eight-hours of The National Rifle Association Basic Pistol Course.

The Oneida County Pistol Licensing Office does not require any additional training, including follow-up classes in “live fire” or personal protection classes, in order to obtain any type or class of license. The first portion of the NRA Basic Pistol Course is all that is required.

If your pistol license is issued restricted to sporting purposes after you have had it for one year you can apply for a full carry license. To obtain that you will still need an EXTRAORDINARY or COMPELLING reason and you will need to take a live fire class prior to turning in the application to the pistol office. All applications **MUST** be picked up in person by the applicant.
