Fire Officer I

Module #3 - Company Training & Community Risk Reduction

Fire Officer I is the second course in a new series addressing command and management in today's fire service and is designed to meet the officer training requirements of the NFPA 1021 Standard. Building on the skills learned Introduction to Fire Officer (45), students begin to examine the transition from firefighter to supervisor. Topics include management and supervision, group dynamics, company level training, community relations, fire department relations, information management, accident/injury investigation, pre-planning and strategy/tactics for multiple company operations.

The course consists of 54 hours of training presented on as follows:

Each module is part of Fire Officer 1 and that all modules must be completed within 2 years to complete Fire Officer 1.
