The April 2019 meeting of the Oneida County Fire Advisory was called to order at 7:00 PM on April 15, 2019. Vice-Chairman Sutherland led the pledge.

Mandryck had distributed the January 2019 meeting minutes to the members before the meeting. There were no corrections offered. A motion to dispense with the reading of the minutes was made by Glenn and seconded by Furgol and the minutes were approved by the board.

The following topics were then discussed:

1. Emergency Services

- a. A zone meeting was recently held that focused on the radio project which resulted in a heated discussion. As a result, the County Chief's Association was asked to submit a list of questions they had regarding the radio program.
- b. The county expects to provide upwards of 500 radios to departments later this year. Police departments will be first in line for the radios.
- c. A question was raised as to whether radios will be provided to ambulance companies. The county attorney's office is researching this issue.
- d. There is still usages with pager coverage in parts of the county. The four ongoing tower site upgrades should help resolve some of these issues. New radio equipment is being installed and connected to the central system in Onondaga County.
- e. The county will be testing the system in schools and buildings with heavy construction.
- f. There is still a problem with open microphones. Training is needed to resolve this issue.
- g. A new smoke house has been ordered with delivery expected in 4 to 6 weeks. The county has been getting a lot of requests for their usage. Glenn has received a quote of \$3000 for a new trailer from Northland Trailers that will be large enough to transport both smoke houses.

4. Expo

- a. Expo scheduled for May 31 from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM. There is no rain date. Over 800 students are expected. More volunteer are needed as only five have signed up todate.
5. Fire Police
 - a. Tony Lambaise was named Fire Police Officer of the Year.
 - b. The County Fire Police has not heard anything from the Boilermaker committee. Waivers need to be completed. Revere will follow up on this.
6. Radio Committee (No Report)
7. EMS
 - a. "Stop the Bleed" training sessions will be held. A schedule of classes will be distributed once training kits have arrived, The 90 minute class will be presented in various parts of the county.
8. Cause and Origin (No Report)
9. Volunteers Association
 - a. One open seat will be filled at the May 16th meeting.
 - b. The convention will be held June 6 through 8 in Verona.
10. Chief's Association
 - a. Recruitment days will be May 27 and 28.
11. Old Business
 - a. One Chief's Association member has not been able to attend since early 2018 due to a possible conflict. Eaton will contact him to discuss a possible replacement. A letter will be sent to Sobol requesting up to two names of individuals that can represent the Chief's Association and fill the vacant seats on the fire advisory board.
 - b. Financial Disclosure forms are to be submitted by legislators and fire chiefs that sit on the fire advisory board. They re due by May 15th.
12. New Business
 - a. A discussion was held regarding mutual aid calls for large events. In some cases, the county has seen numerous requests for mutual aid at the scene or for providing stand by services. In some instances, this could leave some area void of coverage. Officers in charge and deputy coordinators need to work together to avoid this situation.
 - b. Sutherland will coordinate a presentation of drone usage at a scene for the next fire advisory board meeting. Some state agencies have drones that can be requested to assist with an event.
 - c. A request was made to distribute the by-laws of the fire advisory board. Subsequent to the meeting, Mandryck emailed a copy to all members/

 - a. The next meeting will be held May 20, 2019 at 7 PM at DPW.














