#### FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT FOR GRIFFISS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – OBSTRUCTION MITIGATION ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

Oneida County announces the completion of a Final Environmental Assessment (EA) for the proposed Obstruction Mitigation at the Griffiss International Airport. The Final EA has been prepared in accordance with the Federal National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969, as amended, Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Order 1050.1F, and FAA Order 5050.4B. The purpose of this project is to remove obstructions to navigable airspace, enhance the safety of aircraft operations, and comply with federal regulations, design standards, and grant assurances (obligations) with respect to obstructions to airspace. After careful consideration of the information contained in the Final EA, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has determined that significant environmental effects will not result from the proposed action. Therefore, the FAA has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI).
