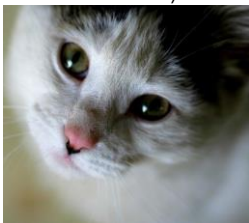

- NYS Public Health Law requires all cats, dogs and ferrets to be vaccinated by 4 months old even if they stay indoors.
- Dogs and cats are required to receive another dose at age 1 and booster doses every 3 years following. Ferrets are required to receive booster doses annually.
- Pets will receive a 1-year certificate if no prior proof of rabies is shown.
- Dogs need to be on a leash and cats need to be in a carrier or laundry basket.
- No exams will be given.
- A \$10 donation per pet is requested to help with costs.
