DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: A Nurse Practitioner is a registered professional nurse with advanced academic and clinical experience, which enables him or her to diagnose and manage most common and many chronic illnesses. Their practice may include the diagnosis of illness and physical conditions and the performance of therapeutic and corrective measures within a specialty area of practice, in collaboration with a licensed physician qualified to collaborate in the specialty involved, provided such services are performed in accordance with a written practice agreement and written practice protocols. This position may supervise licensed and non-licensed staff. The incumbent performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Candidates must meet the minimum qualification at time of application. Either:

Current valid license to practice as a Nurse Practitioner in New York State **AND** must be certified to practice in one or more specific specialty area(s)* related to the work performed and/or location of the position.

*Part 64 of the NYS Commissioner of Education's Regulations lists the following as specialty areas: Acute Care, Adult Health, College Health, Community Health, Family Health, Gerontology, Holistic Care, Neonatology, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Oncology, Pediatrics, Palliative Care, Perinatology, Psychiatry, School Health, and Women's Health.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Certain assignments made to employees in this class will require access to transportation to meet field work requirements in a timely and efficient manner.
2. Possession of a current certificate in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR).

NOTES:

1. Applicant **MUST** submit with application, a copy of current valid license or temporary permit to practice as a Nurse Practitioner in New York State.
2. Applicant **MUST** submit with application, a copy of current CPR certification.
